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
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


Dear Friend,

rave—a word that should only live in a child's life through whimsical play. Scooping up squirmy insects in the cool dirt of the backyard. Dressing in a frilly princess dress and sparkly crown while protecting a cardboard-box castle. Jumping into the swimming pool on a warm summer day.

But for nine-year-old Riley, the need for bravery stomped into her little world at the innocent age of five.

The vibrant green leaves in the playground faded, and the tip of her paintbrush came up dull as she dipped it into the bright puddles of paint. Color blindness rapidly set in, confusing her parents. Such a smart, creative girl—she had known her colors for years.

After weeks of eye exams and genetic testing, one phone call ripped into young Riley's carefree imaginary days, yanking the rug underneath two parents' hopeful feet.

"We got the call on a Tuesday with the Batten disease diagnosis," Riley's mom, Jessica, says.

A quick-progressing, fatal disease instantly had Riley's parents white-knuckling courage, grasping for hope beyond imagination. Their

happy-go-lucky little girl, bursting with a love for princesses, painting, and befriending anyone she met, faced the darkness of vision loss . . . and a future of symptoms no child should bear.

"It's just scary, the thought of living in darkness," Jessica says. "For your baby to have to go through that . . . and she was already afraid of the dark."

With time being of the essence, the perfect companion found his way into the breaking hearts of this family: skilled companion dog Banks.

His tenderness tucks in next to Riley every night—his soft head finding a spot on her pillow. Heads resting closely, Riley finds peace in the night.

"He makes me feel brave," Riley says.









She pulls her courage from each embrace around his soft neck, and her small fingers find comfort in his fur.

While Riley may grow slower than her peers due to Batten disease's neurological effects, Banks remains a constant in her life. Her best friend, never leading too far ahead and never walking too slowly behind. Right next to his person.

"Banks brings a lot of joy and comfort in our sadness," Jessica says. "He's given us something happy to look forward to."

Banks pours out love on the entire family. As Riley's mom and dad witness her brave fight, they often cuddle into Banks' softness, holding onto him for a slice of light amidst their darkness.

With Banks at Riley's side, the family is determined to create beautiful memories together.

From vacationing in the mountains, swimming in the pool, and simple trips to get ice cream on a Friday night, bravery beats in the heart of one little girl because of the four paws of an extraordinary dog.

Seeing the interactions they have together is very sweet. It's nice to see a little happiness amidst the dark we have.





DREAM COMPANION

In the dim morning light, before the sun creeps over the clouds, Charlie awakens to a horrific scene. A vivid memory plays like a nightmare through wide-open eyes and a racing heartbeat.

The barrage of artillery, the screams of terror, and the sight of blood-soaked streets in the war-torn zones of Iraq—

Charlie wrestles to pull his mind from the flashbacks. But it won't budge, stuck on the 70 soldiers he lost during his 24 years of active-duty Army service.

"Sometimes I felt like throwing in the towel," he says. "That's it for me."

The scar on his shoulder, a visible reminder of the gunshot wound that sent him spiraling from a helicopter.

The metal plates throughout his body, relentless sources of pain from 15 surgeries.

The anxiety, paralyzing him like a zombie wandering through the present while trapped in the fog of the past.

He sought peace through civilian life, but only service dog Lois could make that possible. "Lois saved my life," Charlie says. "If I didn't have her, I don't know where I'd be."

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ois stares steadily into Charlie's eyes, offering a connection he never thought possible. A bond too powerful to believe.

As Charlie navigates a world full of people who simply cannot grasp the horrors of his five deployments, he finds peace in a set of soulful eyes and gentle paws that truly get it. Lois senses

when something is wrong even before the dread hits the pit of Charlie's stomach.

"She motivates me to keep going. She reminds me to never give up," he says.

Lois propels Charlie forward as he prepares for triathlons,

steadfastly watching over him as he trains on his indoor bike, inspiring him to step outside, hike, and find peace in nature.

She's also there on the days when the anguish comes roaring back . . . like the one that he awoke to only weeks after welcoming Lois into his life.

The roar of gunfire. Haunting visions of the day in Iraq in 2009 when he lost three soldiers. Suddenly, he felt a gaze softly pulling his mind out of the terror: Lois.

As the sun illuminates the sky each morning, Charlie finds solace, and Lois finds purpose.
